#### Four gentle reminders:

☞ The Nativity of the Lord is a holiday of obligation: **every able Catholic must attend Holy Mass that day under penalty of grave sin:** either Midnight Mass (even before midnight), or the Dawn Mass, or the Mass of the Day (Holy Communion can be received at the Midnight Mass and also at one of the two others if one wishes).

☞ **To receive Holy Communion:** one must be a Catholic, in state of grace, one-hour fasting at least. In the EF liturgy, Holy Communion is received kneeling (unless unable to) and **always on the tongue**. Thank you in advance.

☞ **FSSP clergy do not retain** Christmas and Easter collections for personal use. All Christmas collections will be used for the day-to-day running of St Mary's Shrine (which includes the food, lodgings, pension allowance and salary of your priests).

☞ **Did you know? St Mary's Shrine costs £1,444/week to run and maintain.** Your generosity is greatly appreciated.
