
Marriage banns: Mr Joshua

the Archbishop, at a special service in the Cathedral,
will celebrate formally the calling of a Synod for the
Archdiocese of Liverpool. This Service will begin an
important period of time leading up to the Synod itself
in October 2020. As the Archbishop himself said in
his Pastoral Letter for Synod Sunday 2018 the Synod
is the time when we choose the path to walk on.
Everyone is welcome to come to this service.
