

MANY THANKS from all the clergy for all the cards, gifts and donations received at Christmas! A big thankyou too to everyone who worked so hard to make our Christmas celebrations here at St Mary's so beautiful (cleaning/decorating the church; serving; singing; etc.)!

The *Te Deum* is sung after 11am Mass on New Year's Eve, in thanksgiving for all blessings received in 2023. A *plenary indulgence* is gained under the usual conditions. Also, **Exposition & Benediction** to see the old year out, from 11pm to midnight, with singing of *Te Deum*.

Veni, Creator Spiritus sung before Mass on New Year's Day, to implore divine assistance for 2024, also with *plenary indulgence* attached.

2024 wall calendars (FSSP UK & Ireland edition) are available from the narthex for a suggested minimum donation of $\pounds 2$ (money to be placed in the metal safe).

Epiphany water blessing after 12.10pm Mass on Friday 5 January: if bringing your own water, try to <u>minimize</u> the number of bottles — and <u>no small</u> bottles, please! Alternatively, empty bottles can be filled afterwards from the holy-water container at the side of the church; blessed chalk also available for 'chalking the doors'.

Penitents are requested to *switch OFF mobile phones* (not just silenced or in 'flight mode') <u>before</u> entering the confessional, on advice from the archdiocese.
