Candlemas (Feast of the Purification of the B.V. Mary): Sung Mass at 12.10pm, with Blessing of Candles and Procession. This blessing is primarily intended for candles to be used in the procession and in the liturgy during the coming year. If you'd like to bring your own candles to be blessed, however, please place them in front of the altar rails at least 15 minutes before Mass.


