NOTICES

Consecration of FSSP to Immaculate Heart of Mary will be renewed publicly on Sunday 11 February (impeded Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes) after 11am Mass. Please join in with the first half of the prayer.

Ash Wednesday (14 February — St Valentine not celebrated this year!): day of *fast and abstinence*. All Catholics aged 18-59 inclusive are obliged to fast (one meal & two small snacks permitted); and all Catholics aged 14+ must abstain from meat. (Reminder that *all* days of Lent, excluding Sundays, are days of penance too.)

Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of Obligation, but the faithful are encouraged to mark the beginning of Lent by assisting at Mass. Sung Mass here at 12.10pm; Low Mass at 7pm; both with imposition of ashes.

Lenten Almsgiving: Please give generously to our appeal for *Life*, a nationwide pregnancy-support charity. Donations should be placed in marked box in narthex.

Fridays in Lent (starting 16 February): Solemn Stations of the Cross after 12.10pm Mass, with Benediction with Relic of the True Cross. We are grateful to Fr Jolly for kindly donating this relic to the Shrine. Plenary indulgence available, as always, for praying the Stations.

Chair of St Peter (22 February): plenary indulgence available for members of Confraternity of St Peter. (Flyers available in church porch, if you'd like to join.)
