**Good Friday** (29 March) is a day of *fast and abstinence*. All Catholics aged 18-59 inclusive are obliged to fast (one meal & two small snacks permitted); and, as usual, all Catholics aged 14+ must abstain from meat.

**2nd Collection on Good Friday:** annual *Pontifical Collection* to preserve the Holy Places in the Holy Land and to support Christians in the Middle East.

**Plenary indulgences** during Sacred Triduum: on *Maundy Thursday* at the singing of *Tantum ergo* after the Procession; on *Good Friday* by *adoring and kissing the Cross* at the Solemn Liturgy; on *Holy Saturday* by joining in the *renewal of baptismal promises* at the Vigil.

**Sacred Triduum:** please note special times of Confessions and Masses/liturgies during these days (28-30 March) overleaf.

**First Friday** on Easter Friday: additional 7pm Mass, followed by devotions to the Sacred Heart.
