Fathers Goddard, Verrier, Homolya, Stewart and Jolly wish you and your loved ones a very happy and blessed Christmas! Thank you for all your many kind cards, gifts and donations! Thank you to all who worked so hard to make our Christmas celebrations here so beautiful.

There are 7am Masses on the following days over the next two weeks: Fri 3rd Jan 2025, Mon 6th, Thu 9th, Fri 10th, Sat 11th. (N.B. No confessions before).

On New Year's Eve Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction from 11pm until midnight with a sung *Te Deum*. Mulled wine and mince pies to follow in the church narthex.

Solemn Blessing of Epiphany Water will take place at 5pm on Sunday 5 January in place of Vespers & Benediction. *If you want to bring your own water to be blessed, please try to minimise the number of bottles — and no small bottles, please! Alternatively, empty bottles can be filled afterwards from the holy-water container at the side of the church.*

Blessed chalk will also be available for the custom of 'chalking the doors'.
