Building work in the transepts of the church have begun. Please use the centre aisle only when coming to Holy Communion or returning to the pews. The work will not interfere with our Mass schedule, but it may disturb the Rosary and devotions on weekdays.

There are 7am Masses on the following days over the next two weeks: Mon 24th, Tue 25th, Thu 27th, Fri 28th, and Sat 1st March; and then Mon 3rd, Tue 4th, Thu 6th, and Sat 8th. (N.B. No confessions before).

Ash Wednesday: day of *fast and abstinence*. All Catholics aged 18-59 inclusive are obliged to fast (one meal & two small snacks permitted); and all Catholics aged 14+ must abstain from meat. (Reminder that *all* days of Lent, excluding Sundays, are days of penance too.)

Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of Obligation, but the faithful are encouraged to mark the beginning of Lent by assisting at Mass.
