All Catholics aged 18-59 inclusive are obliged to fast (one meal & two small snacks permitted); and, as usual, all Catholics aged 14+ must abstain from meat. Plenary indulgences during Sacred Triduum: on *Maundy Thursday* at the singing of *Tantum ergo* after the Procession; on *Good Friday* by *adoring and kissing the Cross* at the Solemn Liturgy; on *Holy Saturday* by joining in the *renewal of baptismal promises* at the Vigil. Please note special times of liturgies during these days.
