The Feast of All Saints falls on Sat 1st November, but this year it is not a holy day of obligation, as the feast is transferred to Sunday in the new calendar. Our 9am and 11am Masses on Sunday will be of the *External Solemnity of All Saints*.

According to the 1962 Missal, All Souls' Day is on *Mon 3rd November*, since the 2nd of November falls on a Sunday.

Holy Souls envelopes are available at the church entrance for lists of your deceased loved ones, with alms if you wish. These lists will be placed on the altar, and throughout November those named will be remembered at the *Memento for the Dead* in every Mass. N.B. This is NOT the same as requesting a Mass for a particular intention.

Plenary indulgences applicable only to the Poor Souls may be gained from *1st to 8th November*. See the online newsletter for detailed conditions.
