Ash Wednesday: day of *fast and abstinence*. All Catholics aged 18-59 inclusive are obliged to fast (one meal & two small snacks permitted); and all Catholics aged 14+ must abstain from meat. It is not a Holy Day of Obligation, but the faithful are encouraged to mark the beginning of Lent by assisting at Mass.

The **Feast of the Chair of St Peter** is transferred to *Mon 23rd February*. A plenary indulgence is granted, under the usual conditions, to members of the FSSP and of the Confraternity of St Peter.
